I am authorizing to order the above referenced work including labor & parts, for the vessel listed above. I agree to pay regular retail prices in cash or upon credit terms acceptable to you upon the completion of the work described above. Should I fail to pay for the completed work, I understand you will have a lien upon the above described vessel to secure payment for the work and I expressly waive all state law exemption rights with respect to this vessel. Should collection by suit or any other method be required, I agree to pay (1) interest at the rate of eighteen percent (18%) per annum (but in no event more than the maximum rate permitted by law) on the amount due until paid. (2) All collection fees incurred and (3) any attorney's fees incurred in the collection process. I agree not to hold Handy Boat Service, Inc. (here after known as HBS) liable for any loss or damage caused by theft, fire or any other causes beyond HBS's control, to personal property delivered to HBS for repair, sale or storage, and authorize HBS and its employees to operate the above referenced vessel at my risk in connection with servicing, repairing, testing, inspection or delivery of the watercraft.

The flat rate charge for the winter storage package, sail or power, covers the storage of the vessel at Handy Boat in the off season (September 1 - May 31) All services performed as part of the winter storage package facilitate the storage of the vessel and can not be considered as separate items. These services can not be discounted if not performed. The owner of the vessel is responsible for the entire winter storage bill once the vessel is hauled.

THE RIGHT IS RESERVED TO SUBSTITUTE PARTS FOR THOSE CURRENTLY UNAVAILABLE. STORAGE CHARGES WILL BE ADDED ON ALL ITEMS NOT PICKED UP 10 DAYS AFTER NOTIFICATION OF COMPLETION OF SERVICE.

To cover the cost of shop supplies and environmental fees we have a shop charge of 2% total labor.
