



## Hurricane Plan for Customers

1. Move your boat to a safe harbor if possible
2. Remove all sails, boom, dodgers, biminis, life rings, dinghies,, etc. that are windage or may be blown away.
3. Secure any and all gear that may be lost or cause damage if it moves around especially anchors, etc.
4. Check all pennants and add chafe gear. Add an extra pennant.
5. Dropping your anchor is not recommended, as it will become tangled in the mooring chain as the wind changes.
6. If you have a dinghy, it is advisable to take it home (our dinghy rack is not considered a safe place for storm conditions).
7. We will run our launch service as long as weather permits.
